STATEMENT OF INTENT

This policy applies to all products produced by Tarac for human consumption.

AIMS and OBJECTIVES

- 1) To ensure that all food products are produced, stored, handled, and transported in accordance with the Australian and New Zealand Food Standards Code and all relevant state legislation, regulations, codes of practice and standards.
- 2) To ensure that adequate management systems and controls are in place.
- 3) To ensure that all risks associated with food products are reduced to acceptable levels.
- 4) To ensure that all food handlers have the necessary skills, knowledge, and competence to undertake their duties.

Tarac will ensure this policy is made available to all staff and will seek to ensure that its content is understood by all.

REVIEW

This policy will be kept under review and revised according to the policy review schedule or as necessary to keep up to date with legislative or organisational change.
